This report is built from what people actually said and what search engines actually show — not from a language model's opinion. The pipeline: harvest real complaints → group them into jobs people are trying to do → verify each group against keyword and competition data → keep only what survives.

HOW SCORING WORKS

Pain score asks: is the need real? It weighs how many people voiced the problem, how many already pay for it in time (manual workarounds) or money, and whether anyone already serves them well. Evidence of effort outweighs raw search volume — ten people who each built a spreadsheet beat a big keyword with no complaints behind it.

Build score asks: can a small team actually ship and reach this? It starts from the product shape (a browser tool is cheaper than a mobile app), then adjusts for ranking difficulty and, for directories, whether there is anything real to list.

CONFIDENCE TIERS — READ THESE HONESTLY

VERIFIED GAP

3+ independent complaints *and* hard evidence: a costly manual workaround or an explicit willingness to pay. Checked against live search data.

EMERGING SIGNAL

A coherent pattern from 2+ voices, without hard evidence yet. Cheaper to validate than to ignore — but thinner. We label it instead of hiding it.

What this report does not claim.

We do not predict revenue. We do not claim these are the only gaps in this market. Complaints with a single voice behind them were rejected as anecdotes before this stage — 1 of 6 candidate groups did not make this issue. When evidence is thin we say so on the page where it matters.

Invoice line item extractor

A tool that reliably pulls line items from any invoice format without writing rules or prompts.

THE GAP

People need to extract line-item data from diverse invoice PDFs, but existing solutions are either expensive RPA tools, brittle regex or LLMs that fail on layout changes, or require manual coding and debugging.

A tool that gives you the feel of a spreadsheet but stays connected to the source and enforces shared rules so your data doesn't break.

1 **Single-purpose expense tracker**

A one-page web app for freelancers to log expenses and generate reports without learning a complex system.
